(57) **ABSTRACT**

An intrabuccal stretcher has a supporting bar and a pushing part formed at each distal end of the supporting bar, the pushing parts having such a thickness and such a roundish shape as are suitable for pushing against internal sides of buccae. The supporting bar is bent symmetrically with respect to its center and the pushing parts extend outward from the distal ends of the supporting bar. The pushing parts are inserted into an oral cavity with the supporting bar remaining partly outside the oral cavity to push and stimulate internal sides of the buccae.
