

wire gauze secured to said cylindrical member, the openings between the individual wires of the gauze being large enough so that an insect within the trap is visible from the outside, and a funnel-shaped entrance member of wire gauze having its large open end secured in an opening in said cy-

lindrical member and extending inwardly and terminating in a narrow slot-like opening, said slot-like opening, when viewed from within said trap, blending with the openings between the wires in the wire gauze back ground.
