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dome end, an annular recess in the outer wall of said section for supporting a pocket clip, a lower threaded end formed on said upper section adapted to removably receive a hollow pill and capsule supporting section, a pill and capsule discharge opening formed in said last section, a rotatable sleeve mounted on said section for closing said opening, a washer-like spring for frictionally holding said sleeve against free rotation, an end member for holding said spring in operative position and notch and lug means for holding said rotatable sleeve in predetermined positions to open or close said holder.

3. A sectional container for carrying pills and tablets, comprising removable end sections closed at one end, a series of interchangeable hollow intermediate sections threaded to said end sections and to each other, a dispensing section having an annular dispensing slot in the wall thereof, a concentric rotatable closure sleeve around a portion of said dispensing section, a slot in said closure

sleeve adapted to be brought into registry with said slot in said dispensing section, spring means for holding said closure sleeve against free rotation, cooperating lug and notch means formed on said dispensing section and said closure sleeve adapted to hold said sleeve in an open or closed position, and clip means for removably attaching said container within a garment pocket.

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
